





Clayton Bradley Academy Maryville, TN

In 2013, Clayton Bradley Academy opened its doors to Pre-K through 12th grade students. The academy originally consisted of 6 modular buildings used for science labs, classrooms, and teachers offices which were connected by a 8,600 square foot administration building. But with ongoing support and growing interest, the academy decided to expand by adding buildings for lower and upper level grades, a student union building and a new auditorium. Johnson Architecture designed the buildings. S2A assisted in development of architecture design documentation through creation of the Building information Model.
