



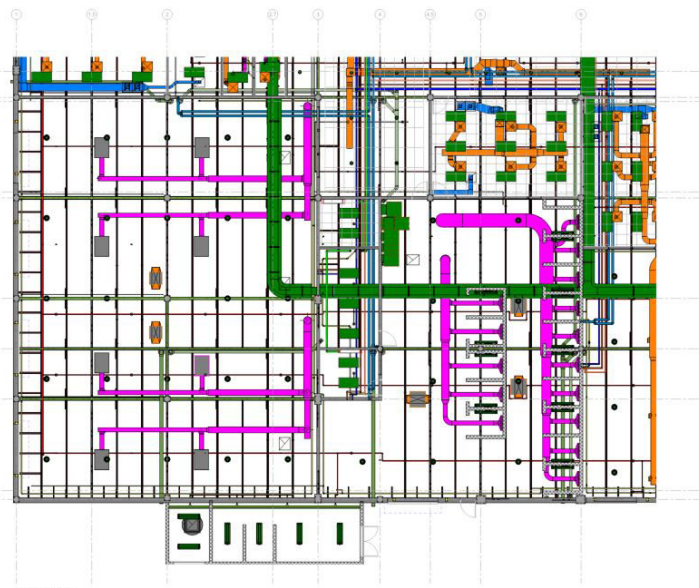
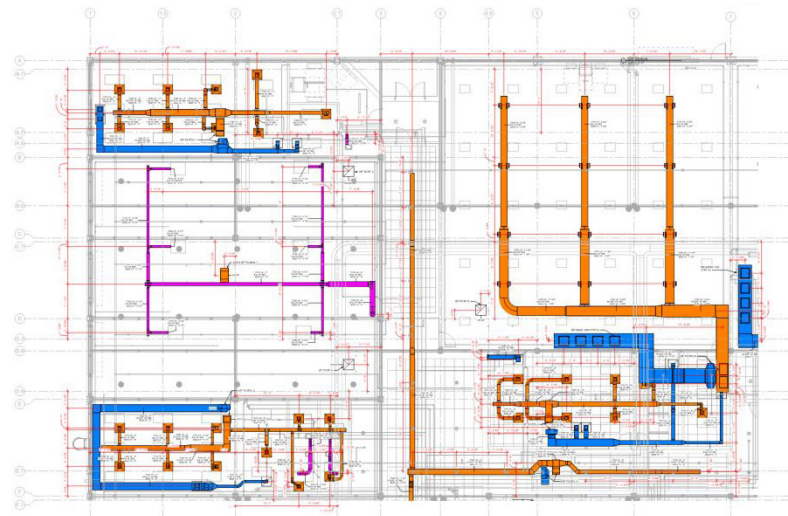
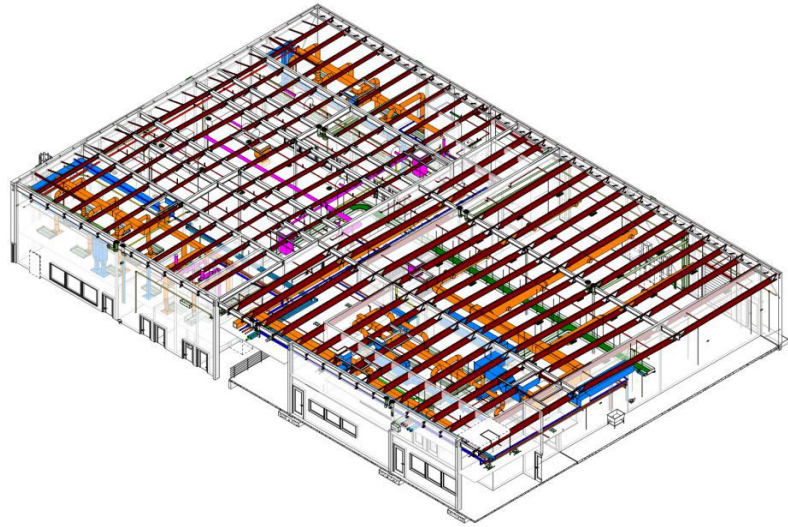
Anderson County Higher Education Center

The new center is part of former Governor Bill Haslam’s “Drive to 55 Initiative” that aims to get 55% of Tennesseans a college degree by 2025.

The building has numerous classrooms, machine tool labs, automotive technology labs, plastic injections lab as well as a welding lab.
