



Neyland Stadium South Renovations

University of Tennessee, Knoxville, TN

S2A has had an ongoing supporting role in the design and construction of the multiphase renovation of the University of Tennessee's Neyland Stadium. This portion of the renovation is a \$340M enhancement which includes renovation of the south ground level as well as levels one, two, and three concourses. These renovations include new entry towers, gates, and plaza areas, the addition of a kitchen and commissary for on-site catering, development of premium club and suite spaces and the adjustment of the field wall in the south end zone to improve player safety and conform to NCAA guidelines. Improvements were also made to the stadium exterior to better integrate the stadium into the architectural fabric of the campus.
